# Dilution

Maintenance: 24 Parts Water to 1 Part Product

#### Application

Pre-wet a large area of the surface to be cleaned. Apply the diluted material liberally with a soft brush or low pressure spray. Allow the cleaner to work for 2 minutes. The time may also vary depending on cleaning conditions, temperatures, soil buildup and type of substrate. Rinse thoroughly with high pressure spray equipment and fresh water.

#### **Storage Instructions**

Product may become unstable if cooled below 40°F. Keep product warm and above bare concrete floors. If product becomes unstable, add hot water and mix well. Product may be used if thawed properly. Store in a cool, dry place. Provide ventilation for receptacles. Store away from foodstuffs. Store away from oxidizing agents. Do not store together with alkalis (caustic solutions). Keep container tightly sealed.


