Directions

Clean object thoroughly. Apply Rubber and vinyl Renewer evenly with a cloth, sponge or spray applications onto dry surfaces. Allow sufficient penetrating time then buff off excess. Retreat as often as necessary. Rubber and Vinyl Renewer maintains vinyl, plastics, finished leather and rubber products. Repels dirt and makes surfaces anti-static. Protects against ozone and ultraviolet deterioration. Pleasant odor, non-toxic, non-flammable and non-corrosive. Do NOT us on floors or fabrics

Storage Instructions


