Storage Instructions

Wear all appropriate Personal Protective Equipment (PPE). Wear respiratory protection or ensure adequate local ventilation at all times as vapors can accumulate in confined or poorly ventilated areas. Avoid aerosolizing product. Use the product in a manner which minimizes splashes and/or the creation of dust. Keep containers closed when not in use. Store at room temperatures, i.e., 40 to 95°F (4 to 35°C). Store in a cool location. Provide ventilation for receptacles. Store away from foodstuffs. Do not store together with acids. Store in cool, dry conditions in well sealed receptacles. Keep container tightly sealed.






Precautionary statements:

In case of fire: Use dry sand, dry chemical or alcohol-resistant foam to extinguish. In case of major fire and large quantities: Evacuate area. Fight fire remotely due to risk of explosion. Store locked up. Dispose of contents/container in accordance with local/regional/national/international regulations.
