Storage Instructions

Wear all appropriate Personal Protective Equipment (PPE). Wear respiratory protection or ensure adequate ventilation at all times as vapors can accumulate in confined or poorly ventilated areas. Avoid aerosolizing product. Use the product in a manner which minimizes splashes and/or the creation of dust. Keep containers closed when not in use. Store at room temperatures, i.e., 40 to 95 F (4 to 35 C). Do not allow product to come in contact with aluminum or soft metals. Store in a cool location. Provide ventilation for receptacles. Use only fluoropolymer or plastic containers and tubing. Store away from foodstuffs. Store away from alkalis. Do not store together with other acids. Store in cool, dry conditions in well sealed receptacles. Keep container tightly sealed.


