### **Storage Instructions**

Product may become unstable if cooled below 40°F. Keep product warm and above bare concrete floors. If product becomes unstable, add hot water and mix well. Product may be used if thawed properly. Store in a cool, dry place. Use only receptacles specifically permitted for this substance/product. Use receptacles with fluoroplastic lining. Unsuitable material for receptacle: aluminum, steel, glass or ceramic. Provide ventilation for receptacles. Store away from foodstuffs. Store away from oxidizing agents. Do not store together with alkalis (caustic solutions). Store away from metals. Keep container tightly sealed.


