



# Powder-C

Powder-C is an alkaline vehicle body prep soap designed to aid in the removal of stubborn dirt. Works best with hot water.

## **Directions**

Mix 50 pounds (1 box) of Powder-C with 50 gallons of water. Product will dissolve faster in warm or hot water. Mix well until completely dissolved. Add 1 gallon Powder Booster Liquid Concentrate (CW204) if desired and mix well.

### **Dilution**

After the product is dissolved in water:

Tunnel: 8 to 100 Parts Water to 1 Part Product In Bay: 8 to 100 Parts Water to 1 Part Product Self-serve: 8 to 100 Parts Water to 1 Part Product

## **Storage Instructions**

Wear all appropriate Protective Equipment (PPE). Wear respiratory protection or ensure adequate ventilation at all times to avoid generating product dust. Keep containers closed when not in use. Store at room temperature, i.e., 40 to 95° F (4 to 35°C). Do not allow product to come in contact with aluminum. Do not use aluminum tools for handling. Store in a cool location. Provide ventilation for receptacles. Store away from foodstuffs. Do not store together with acids. Store in cool, dry conditions in well-sealed receptacles. Keep container tightly sealed.


