

Truck Wash Concentrate

Heavy Acid Mix for Economical Truck Wash

Directions

Dilute with water before use. The proper dilution depends upon the nature of the work and the temperature while doing it. Can be brushed (natural fiber) or high pressure washed. Always work from the bottom upward, both on application and rinse. Once applied, permit the solution to work for 10 minutes prior to rinsing.

Concentrations can set approximately as follows:

Brush: 50:1

Pressure Washer: 60:1.

Do not allow to dry on surfaces, rinse completely. Keep off roofs of trailers to prevent later "weeping" and streaks.

Protective clothing including chemical goggles, face shield, rubber gloves and rubber "chemical" suit must be worn.

Storage Instructions

Product may become unstable if cooled below 40°F. Keep product warm and above bare concrete floors. If product becomes unstable, add hot water and mix well. Product can be used if thawed properly. Store in cool, dry place. Use only receptacles specifically permitted for this substance/product. Use receptacles with fluoroplastic lining. Unsuitable material for receptacle: aluminum, steel, glass or ceramic.

Provide ventilation for receptacles. Store away from foodstuffs. Store away from oxidizing agents. Do not store together with alkalis (caustic solutions). Store away from metals. Keep container tightly sealed.
